

### **COVID-19 Student Safeguards and Guidelines**

- The number of students in each class is limited to ensure everyone can maintain a safe physical distance of 6 feet from others who are not from your household. Instructors will also maintain a physical distance of 6 feet from students.
- In adherence to the state guidelines, students and instructors must wear face coverings for the duration of the class and while in all indoor areas. Face masks must be worn outdoors whenever it is difficult to maintain a safe physical distance of 6 feet from others who are not from your household and when talking to Garden staff.
- Hand sanitizing stations and disposable face masks will be available in Mt. Cuba's classroom and in common areas in the Main House. You are required to use hand sanitizer when entering the building and classrooms.
- Food and beverages (including water) are not currently available at Mt. Cuba Center, please bring your own water bottle to class if desired.
- Please stay 6 feet away from people outside your own party, including Garden staff. In accordance with state guidelines, a face covering is required when you're within 6 feet of people outside your own party. If you are sick or have been in contact with someone who is sick, please stay home

### **Classrooms and Disinfecting Measures**

- Work surfaces, shared materials, and routinely touched surfaces will be cleaned between each class.
- Routine cleaning and disinfecting of shared objects such as payment terminals, phones if used, etc. will take place in between uses.
- Guest restrooms and routinely touched surfaces are cleaned frequently throughout the day.
- Mt. Cuba Center uses disinfectants and cleaning solutions that are EPA-approved as recommended by the CDC.

The health and safety of our staff, guests, and volunteers is our priority. We will continue to monitor guidance from government officials and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and assess Garden operations and make changes if needed.
